# Lakadong Turmeric (GI tag Meghalaya )

- Lakadong Turmeric is world's most potent turmeric with a curcumin range of 7-9%
- Lakadong is a secluded village still untouched by industrialisation. Only locals and small-scale farming organizations are involved in the production of India's most authentic and aromatic turmeric
- Given the high curcumin content, the health-aiding and culinary enhancing attributes of Lakadong turmeric is more than regular turmeric it is not surprising that this naturally grown variety in Meghalaya is one of the most sought after spices across the world.



# King Chilli (GI tag Nagaland)

- Nagaland King Chilli belongs to the genus Capsicum of family Solanaceae. Naga King Chilli is considered as the world's hottest chilli and is constantly in the top five of the world's hottest chilies based on the Scoville Heat Units (SHUs).
- Known by various names such as Bhutjolokia or Ghost Chilli in Assam; Naga Jolokia or Raja Mircha in Nagaland and Umorok or Go-morok in Manipur
- High capsaicin 3-5% (amongst the highest in the world)



# Large Cardamom (GI tag Arunachal Pradesh)

- Large/Black Cardamom comes from the hills of Arunachal Pradesh, Sikkim and Nagaland.
- Available in Mooch Cut/ Oven SMoked/ Sun Dried
- Oil is used in Soaps, Oral care, Perfumery
- High use in Biryanis/ Ready to eat spices/ Dry Rub



## Bird eye Chilli / Mizo Chilli (GI tagged )

- Mizochilli/ Bird Eye Chilli are smaller in size and hotter than the normal Indian red chilli. In terms of pungency, it measures around 50,000- 100,000 Scoville units
- Mizo Chilli contains 7 times the vitamin C level to that of an orange. The health benefits include fighting sinus congestion, aiding digestion, migraine relief and relief from muscle, joint and nerve pain. It's also a good source of vitamins A and E, Beta-Carotene, Folic Acid and Potassium



# Karbi Anglong Ginger (GI tag Assam )

- Karbi Ginger is one of the best variants of organic ginger and comes from Singhashan Hills of Assam.
- Two varieties Naida (Fibrous) & Aizol (Less Fibre)
- High Dry Rhizome variety with higher oleoresin content
- Available in Fresh/Dry (Whole/Powder)



# Star Anise (GI tag Arunachal Pradesh )

- Star anise is used in culinary for signature flavours and is one of the ingredients found in garam masala and is present in the ‘five-powder’ mix. It is used to flavour meat, vegetables, pickling and for marinating purposes. The essential oil present in the star anise is also used to flavour soft drinks.
- High Shikimic acid content (Antiviral & antimicrobial)
- High in Anti oxidants



# Dalle Khursani/Lifetaker Chilli (GI tag Sikkim)

- One of the hottest chillis in the world with a range of 10000-350000 SHU
- Dalle Khursani is added to sauces, pickles, and pastes to increase their pungency and for flavour. It is also known for its medicinal properties. It is rich in vitamin A, vitamin E, vitamin C, and Potassium, while low on Sodium.
- 100 gms of fresh Dalle Khursani has 240 mg of vitamin C (5 times higher than in an Orange), 11,000 IU of vitamin A, and 0.7 mg of vitamin E.



# Cinammon (GI tag Meghalaya)

- Cinnamon spice in North East India is grown naturally without the use of any artificial fertilizers. Farmers from Mawtnum village in Meghalaya use age-old traditional farming methods to cultivate them.
- Used in Nutraceuticals (blood sugar , digestive tonics) apart from the food industry.



# Black Rice/Chak Hao Rice (GI tag Manipur )

- Chak-hao, as Black Rice is called in Manipur is a scented glutinous rice
- It is considered as one of the richest source of anthocyanin found among food products apart from optimal content of vitamins, minerals, fibre, proteins, and many other nutrients.
